



## Next Generation Summer Intern - Job Description

### Guiding Scriptures:

**Ephesians 4:11-13:** It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, to prepare God's people for works of service so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

**Matthew 28:18-20:** Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

### Purpose:

This role will be at the heart of Town + Field Church's network by helping coordinate the next generation ministries from July to August.

### Accountability:

While under the supervision of the Director of Ministries, he or she will serve, in community, as part of the staff team contributing to the team spirit and participating in devoted relationships to one another.

### Responsibilities:

- 1. Mighty Mites Camp** – Coordinate, Plan, and execute multiple summer camps for Next Generation Ministries. This will involve working with the Summer Next Gen Team in planning and executing the summer Might Mites Sports day camp (preparing materials, recruiting leaders, assisting in communication, participating in the week of camp).
- 2. Youth Ministry Summer Activities** – Working with the Student Ministries Staff to plan and execute Youth Ministry Summer Activities.
- 3. Next Gen Programming** – helping plan, prepare, and participate in events and programs for Kids Town, UpTown, or Town + Field Youth, as time and skills allow.
- 4. Fall Launch Preparations** – planning and preparing for Fall Next Generation programs (including but not limited to improving environments, recruiting volunteers, and preparing supplies)
- 5. Ongoing Development** – participate in weekly meetings and leadership development.

### Qualifications:

- 1. Growing Disciple** – Demonstrated passion for the person and mission of Jesus and a commitment to Spirit-filled living.
- 2. Integral** – Relentlessly trustworthy in stewarding the responsibilities, resources and people entrusted to him/her.
- 3. Energetic** – Thrives in a fast-paced work environment and responds well under pressure.
- 4. Experienced** – Enjoys working with children and families and planning and coordinating events for children and families.
- 5. Fun** – Loves to laugh loud, hard and often. Believes that nothing is more enjoyable than serving God with the people you love.
- 6. Missional** – Evidenced heart for evangelism/mission.
- 7. Committed** – Wholeheartedly affirm and support the Town + Field Church Vision, Values, Statement of Faith and Leadership Agreement.

### Time Requirements:

The individual will carry out his/her responsibilities by working 30-35 hours per week for 7-8 weeks between the months of from July 2 to August 30.

Full participation and availability during Mighty Mites Camp (August 19-23) is a requirement.
